Thank you to all that have supported Calvert Athletic Boosters Club for the 2022-2023 athletic year. We would like to offer you the opportunity to support our Academy and High School athletic teams with this 2023-2024 membership drive. This past year we had 183 donors and would love to hit a goal of 200 donors this year. Calvert provides athletic programs for student-athletes, including baseball, basketball, cheerleading, cross country, football, golf, softball, swimming, tennis, track & field, volleyball and wrestling. Additionally, programs are also offered to Academy student-athletes including basketball, cheerleading, cross country, football, track & field, volleyball, and wrestling.

The Athletic Booster Club was created to offer alumni, parents, friends, and fans the opportunity to be partners in planning and supporting fundraising efforts for Calvert Academy and High School Athletics. Our purpose consists of raising funds for the Calvert's Department of Athletics, providing volunteers to serve the department as needed, and extending & promoting the spirit of Calvert Catholic Schools throughout the Tiffin Community.

We welcome all parents and family members of students from the Calvert Elementary, Academy, and High School to join and participate in club planning and activities. The club meets the **first Wednesday of each month at 7pm** at Calvert Academy and High School. The participation is needed and vital for the future success of the Calvert Athletic Programs.

This past 2022-2023 academic year, many of our athletic programs experienced great success, including the following:

**CC** – Competed in SBC River Division finished 3rd.

**Football** – 6-5 Overall

**Boys' Golf** – Competed in SBC and finished 5<sup>th</sup> as a team

**Girls' Golf** – Team competed at State and finished 12th

**Volleyball**-Overall (16-0 SBC) – Regional Finalist

**Boys' Basketball** – 20-5 Overall ( SBC Co-Champs)

**Girls' Basketball** – 12-12 Overall (7-9 SBC)

**Baseball** – 30-3 Overall (16-0 SBC) District Champs, Regional Champions, State Semi-Finalist

**Softball** – 19-8 Overall (8-6 SBC) District Runner-up

**Boys' Track & Field** – 4<sup>th</sup> place SBC (Jacob Rombach 9th in Long jump, 4th in the 400. Jacob Rombach, Billy Clouse, Lee Morgan, Cal Warnement 4x200 State qualifiers)

**Girls' Track & Field** – 1st place SBC (Leah Smith, Brooklyn Brown, Emily Miller, Camryn Shook State Champions 4x200 relay. Leah Smith 1st place 100 meter dash. Emily Miller, Brooklyn Brown, Camryn Shook, Caroline Lanicek 3<sup>rd</sup> place 4x400 meter relay. Leah Smith 9th place 200 meter)

For the 2023-2024 academic year, the Athletic Boosters Club will provide the Academy & High School athletic teams with over \$50,000. Expenses include purchasing new equipment, as well as uniforms for various teams (based on a rotational basis). In addition, we are involved in the maintenance of buildings at the Field House/Athletic Complex, and providing updates and restoration to the high school and elementary gymnasiums.

The total cost to provide free athletics to our Calvert students is \$150,000. The school supplies transportation which on average is \$50,000. The cost of being able to stream home games is \$10,000, this allows for all family and friends to be able to watch Calvert home games from the convenience of home and allows the coaches to use the stream as a tool to help with stats and review the game.



Through efforts focused upon financing Calvert Athletics, the Boosters have provided the following list of fundraisers and events planned for the 2023-2024 academic year:
