## Hall of Fame Inductee 2023

**Linda (Baumgartner) Theis** is a 1967 graduate of Calvert High School. Linda has dedicated the better part of her life to protecting the unborn in activism locally, statewide and nationally with a resume dating to the early 1970s when abortion became legal. She has remained deeply involved with all aspects of the issue—all while raising six children.

Locally, Linda has worked closely at all levels of the Women's Resource Center of Hancock County in Findlay. This busy center offers emotional, financial and moral support to women facing an unplanned pregnancy. Additionally, Linda has been involved with C.A.R.E. Program within Findlay City and Hancock County Schools, serving primarily as a teacher for over 22 years. This program teaches students in grades 6-10 skills in positive relationships, good choices and critical thinking.

At the national and state level, Linda never gave up on the unborn. At age 29, she was the Vice President of Ohio Right to Life under Dr. Jack Wilkie who is considered the father of the modern day pro-life movement and was her personal mentor.

Linda became the first President of Ohio Right to Life who was not in the medical field. She served in this capacity until 1983 when she became more involved on the national level. In 2011, Linda was a co-author of the "Heartbeat Bill." This bill was the first of its kind and many other states mirrored it. The bill was ultimately signed by Ohio Governor Mike DeWine in 2019, becoming law in Ohio in 2022 following the overturn of the federal law on abortion.

Currently, Linda serves as the President of Ohio Pro-Life Action Coalition, a grassroots effort of pro-life groups all over Ohio. She also spoke at the March for Life's National Breakfast in Washington DC. This event brings U.S. Congressman and other leaders together who are concerned and actively working to end abortion in the United States. Additionally, she has helped to organize many trips for Ohioans to participate in the annual event.

Linda's journey has allowed her to meet people from all over the country, making her impact on the fight to end abortion immeasurable. She is a woman of great character and tremendous faith, a true example of what the Calvert community hopes of all graduates.

## Alumnus Honored By President

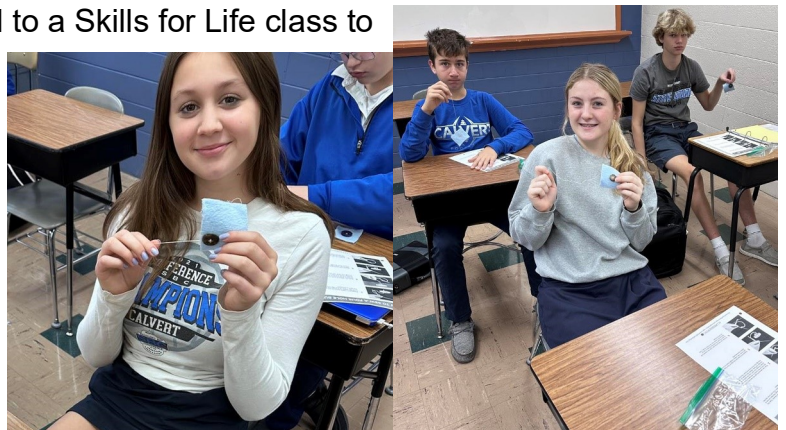
